**NOTICE OF FILING OF ADDENDUM**

In 1994, The Township of Essa completed a Municipal Class C Environmental Assessment (EA) study to develop preferred development strategies to provide a common water supply, storage, and distribution system between Angus and CFB Borden, and to identify additional water sources to accommodate growth. An Environmental Study Report (ESR) was issued in March 1994 entitled *Township of Essa Angus Area/CFB Borden Class Environmental Assessment (Water Works)*.

An Addendum to the ESR was issued in June 2003 to reflect changes to the selected design alternatives presented in the ESR, including a recommendation to maintain separate water systems between Angus and CFB Borden, and to include a potable water connection to the Collingwood-Alliston Pipeline in order to utilize surplus water allocated to the Baxter Community Water System.

Given that implementation of the EA has exceeded five years from filing of the Notice of Completion and 2003 Addendum, an additional Addendum must be issued to review the planning and design process and current environmental setting to ensure that the project and preferred design alternatives are still valid. The review has concluded that an in-ground reinforced concrete reservoir at the Brownley site is preferable to an elevated storage tank. Otherwise, the recommended design strategies for water supply, storage and distribution within the Angus area remain consistent with the approved ESR and 2003 Addendum.

By this notice, the Addendum is being placed on the public record for review in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment. Comments from the Public on the above noted proposed works are invited and will be accepted until August 16, 2010. Subject to the comments received and the receipt of other approvals as necessary, the Township of Essa intends to proceed with implementing the development strategy outlined in the ESR. Please note that only the changes proposed in this Addendum are open for review.

Please provide written comments to the Township Clerk within 30 calendar days from the date of this Notice. If concerns regarding the proposed reservoir cannot be resolved through discussion with the Township and its representatives, a person may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses individual environmental assessments.
