NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Thornton Signalized Pedestrian Crossing

Please be advised that the Township of Essa has recently received tenders for a signalized pedestrian crossing at the Trans Canada Trail and Robert Street/County Road 21, in Thornton.

The scope of work includes the following:

- **Signalized pedestrian crossing including traffic signals, pedestrian push buttons, walk/don't walk signals and a 5.0m wide painted crossing.**

The successful bidder for this project is Guild Electric Ltd. They are expected to commence construction of the project in early May 2021. It is anticipated that the project will be substantially completed by the end of July 2021. Although every effort will be made to limit the amount of disturbance to the residents, some inconveniences such as impeded traffic flows and access to driveways are to be expected. We request that when driving or walking through and around the construction area, that you proceed with caution and obey the construction traffic signage and personnel.

Guild Electric Ltd., Ainley Group and the Township of Essa have strict COVID 19 protocols and procedures in place that will be followed at all times while on site. Similarly, we ask that all residents respect the Provincial Policies in place, including wearing a face covering and maintaining physical distance, if approaching a site representative.
