The County of Simcoe will be resurfacing County Road 27 from the south limits of Thornton to Essa Road. As well as County Road 21 from County Road 27 to William Street.

Construction is anticipated to take commence August 26, 2019 with a scheduled completion date of September 30, 2019. The contractor will maintain access to your home/business, however at times there may be unavoidable minor disruptions.

**Parking Restrictions**

At certain times throughout August & September you will see no parking signs in place in the Village of Thornton. We ask that you refrain from parking on the street between the hours of 6:00 am and 7:00 pm Monday to Thursday and 6:00 am and 3:00 pm on Fridays.

When the construction is completed in the Village of Thornton, the no parking signs and traffic cones will be removed indicating that parking may resume during the daytime hours.

**Garbage & Recycling Collection**

Please ensure your garbage and recyclables are placed at the end of your driveway on your regularly scheduled day to help facilitate the waste collection process during the road construction work.
