



TOWNSHIP OF ESSA ADOPT-A-ROAD PROGRAM

The Adopt-A-Road Program is a township-wide program that encourages community involvement in the maintenance of Township roadsides and is open to community groups and individuals who want to take an active role in enhancing the quality of life in our community. Essa Township partners with local groups or individuals to clean up sections of Township roadsides.

Groups adopting a road enter into a three year agreement with the Township. Under this Agreement, a cleanup must be held at least twice a year along a 2 kilometre stretch of road. The Township will install a sign at each end of the adopted section of road right-of-way to recognize the efforts of the community group or individual. The Township also provides safety vests, garbage bags, information, etc. and the pickup of garbage bags, etc. collected during the roadside clean up.
