Site Planning Process

- 1. Submit application with site plan
 - Site plan fee is \$2,000.00
 - Site plan deposit for legal and engineering expenses is \$2,000.00
 - Site plan should be professionally drawn showing elevations and how stormwater will be addressed (drawn by a professional civil engineer)
- 2. Other Applicable Fees include:
 - Simcoe County Review Fee \$250.
 - NVCA Confirm w/their office
 - Township Fire Dept. Review Fee \$75.
 - List is not inclusive and may involve other applicable fees
- 3. Site plan will be reviewed by Township staff, our consulting engineer, the County of Simcoe and Nottawasaga Valley Conservation Authority (NVCA)
 - County's interest lies with traffic and stormwater management
 - NVCA's interest lies with stormwater management
- 4. An agreement will be drawn up by the Township lawyer, agreement states land will be developed only as approved, changes must be resubmitted for approval from the Municipality
 - Staff must be advised of legal ownership and any interests on property (ie mortgages)
 - All owners and those with interest must sign the site plan agreement (ie bank representatives must sign as a party to the agreement)
 - To save legal fees, staff should be notified of any changes to interest in property (ie new mortgages)
- 5. Applicant to prepare an estimate of the cost of site works, Township consulting engineer is to approve this (security posted in amount of 30%)
- 6. Township Council to approve of site plan, agreement and securities
- 7. Applicant must post securities to cover the above estimate
- 8. Building permit issued once site plan agreement signed, securities posted, and plans reviewed (and applicable fees)
- 9. Development charges to be paid at time of issuance of building permit
