## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESSA

BY-LAW 2007 - 58

A By-law to Amend the wording of Item 3 in By-law 2007-53, being a by-law to Regulate and Control the Breeding of Dogs and Animals within the Township of Essa.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, Chapter c.25, as amended, provides that Municipalities may pass By-laws for licensing, regulating, prohibiting, impounding, muzzling, or selling animals; and

WHEREAS The Council of The Township of Essa did pass By-law 2007-53, known as the Breeding By-law at their meeting on September 19, 2007; and

WHEREAS the Attorney General has requested the addition of certain wording in order to approve the set fines attached to the offences so that they place a duty or prohibition against a specific person or group of persons;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Essa hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Section 3 d shall be amended as follows:

Previous wording:

3 d To provide a buffer for noise attenuation and nuisance control, no breeding kennel license shall be issued unless the kennel complies with the following minimum standards.

To be changed to:

- 3 d Every kennel owner or operator shall ensure that the following minimum standards are met to provide a buffer for noise attenuation and nuisance control.
- 2. That Section 3 g shall be amended as follows:
  - 3 g All kennels shall be operated and maintained in accordance with the following regulations ...

To be changed to:

3 g Every kennel owner or operator shall ensure that the following regulations are met ...

3. This By-law shall come into force and have effect on the day it is finally passed.

READ A FIRST, AND TAKEN AS READ A SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED on this the Third day of October, 2007.
